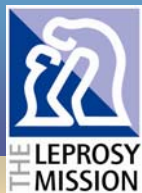

Dear Friends

I am very pleased to introduce you to Coffee and Care. It is an exciting way to help The Leprosy Mission by holding an event to raise support for Bankura vocational training centre in India. Bankura accepts young people from leprosy-affected families and trains them in practical qualifications to give them a real chance of overcoming the effects of leprosy. The courses last from six months to two years and include dressmaking, printing, welding and engineering. They help the young people to support themselves and sometimes parents disabled by leprosy. Bankura provides a wonderful opportunity and a positive response to leprosy.

Coffee and Care will be raising support for student food and we hope to raise enough to feed the students for an entire year. Could you hold an event and raise just £30 for them? Churches, youth groups and schools in the East of England region supported Coffee and Care in 2009 and held: coffee mornings, Church refreshments, prayer breakfasts, pudding evenings and Church lunches. What could you do?
