Instruction to your bank/building society

Please pay The Leprosy Mission England, Wales, the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man (TLMEW) Direct Debits from the account detailed in this instruction, subject to the safeguards assured by the Direct Debit guarantee. Banks and building societies may not accept Direct Debit instructions for some types of account.



The Direct Debit Guarantee (To be retained by the payer)
