The Leprosy Mission depends on legacy gifts to supply the needs of future generations affected by leprosy.

- There are three types of legacies:
- a residuary legacy – a percentage of your estate (after debts, funeral costs and pecuniary gifts)
 - a pecuniary legacy – an amount of money (which can be index-linked to safeguard its future value)
 - a specific legacy – an item to be used or sold by the beneficiary (e.g. car, jewellery, furniture, bank account)
