

## Role Description Fundraising Volunteer

Journalist Eve Sawyer said “Never underestimate the power of passion”. Are you passionate about The Leprosy Mission? Do you want to see the lives of those affected by leprosy and the communities in which they live transformed? Then could you become a fundraising volunteer?

### Purpose of the role

To promote and organise fundraising events to support the work of The Leprosy Mission. These can be large or small. They can involve as many or as few people as you wish. They can be as crazy (a sponsored bungee jump) or as ordinary (a coffee morning) as your skill and imagination allow.

### Main activities

- ✚ To raise funds to support the work of The Leprosy Mission around the world
- ✚ To plan and promote your chosen event(s) using local networks and local media
- ✚ To encourage as many people as possible to support you in your fundraising efforts
- ✚ To ensure that a risk assessment for your event is carried out and it is run with due care and attention to health and safety issues

- ✚ Enthusiasm, imagination and a passion for the work of The Leprosy Mission
- ✚ Cash handling experience or the ability to recruit someone who can help you with this
- ✚ The ability to gather together a group of people to assist in the organisation and promotion of your events
- ✚ Sympathy with the Christian ethos of The Leprosy Mission

- ✚ Your local Area Co-ordinator can provide materials to help publicise your event
- ✚ Sample press releases are available to attract publicity before the event or report on its success
- ✚ Your event can be advertised on your local Area Co-ordinator’s web page at [www.leprosymission.org.uk](http://www.leprosymission.org.uk)
- ✚ Personalised sponsor forms are available for family and friends’ use
- ✚ A named staff contact for 1:1 support and a review at least once a year
