

4-10 September

Pray for God's guidance and wisdom over the plans being drawn up for a new Leprosy Hospital at Anandaban in Nepal (parts of which were damaged in the 2015 earthquakes) and the continued reconstruction of other buildings in Nepal. Pray that the £1.6m needed for the new Trauma Centre will be raised to enable construction to start.

11-17 September



Pray for multi-faith communities in Sri Lanka as they work together to raise awareness of leprosy. Pray that God will touch the hearts of those who hear about leprosy and that people will be moved to respond appropriately.

18-24 September

Pray for Leprosy Mission volunteers working across England and Wales, speaking in churches and telling people about the work we do. Pray God's blessing on them as they give up their own time to help leprosy-affected people.

25 September to 1 October

Pray for the leaders of The Leprosy Missions across the world who are attending the Global Fellowship meetings this week. Ask God to bless them as they seek his guidance and to follow His will for The Leprosy Mission and how best to help people affected by leprosy.

29 May to 4 June

Give thanks for the appointment of Peter Waddup as TLMEW's National Director, from 3 April, and pray for him as he seeks to serve people affected by leprosy in this role. Pray for courage, God's wisdom, guidance and blessing.

5-11 June

As the people of the UK go to the Polls this week pray for those elected to ensure that the UK's commitment to 0.7 per cent overseas aid continues. Pray that government resources help those most in need, including people affected by leprosy.

12-18 June

Please uphold in prayer, TLMEW staff travelling overseas to Mozambique, Nepal, Niger and Sri Lanka over the next few months, as they continue the vital work of supporting international colleagues. Pray for their safety and protection and ask God to give them strength and wisdom.

19-25 June

Pray for people across the world who will go to a Leprosy Mission hospital or clinic and receive the news that they have leprosy this week. Pray that fear will be kept far from them and that they will have an assurance of the love of God from the kindness and practical treatment they receive.



26 June to 2 July

Pray for the work of The Leprosy Mission in Ethiopia, that many more people will be diagnosed and treated,

preventing permanent disability. Pray for the staff of TLM-Ethiopia, for protection and God's guiding hand to be upon them.

3-9 July

Pray for elderly people who were diagnosed with leprosy before there was a cure. Many are severely disabled as a result and have suffered unimaginable rejection by families and friends. Pray that the love of God would shine in their lives through the ministry of The Mission.

10-16 July

Pray for the CREATE project in India which will train Leprosy Champions to stand up for people who are hated or thought less of, because of leprosy. Pray for those who feel ashamed, alone or worthless because of how other people have treated them.

17-23 July

Pray for God's blessing on TLMEW's work with TLM-Bangladesh and Government health centres in Bangladesh, to help leprosy-affected people living in the remote Chittagong Hill Tracts. Pray for people in this poor area to have enough to eat and to be able to feed their families.

24-30 July

Please uphold the staff and volunteers of TLM-Nigeria in your prayers. Pray for the leprosy-affected people they reach out to, and that Nigerian churches would be inspired to help those living in their local communities. Pray for acceptance and love to be expressed to those who suffer so much rejection.

31 July to 6 August

Pray for the work of The Leprosy Mission across the world: that people will stand up against discrimination and stigma towards leprosy-affected people. Pray for barriers to be broken down and for misconceptions and misunderstandings to be dismantled.

7-13 August

Pray for the wisdom and guidance of the Board of Trustees as they oversee the governance of The Leprosy Mission England and Wales. Give thanks for the appointment of Ralph Turner to the chair of Trustees at TLMEW and for the appointment of Colin Osborne to the chair of the International Board of Trustees.

14-20 August



Pray for leprosy-affected people living in Sudan and South Sudan. Pray for their protection from harm and that our loving Father God would meet their every need.

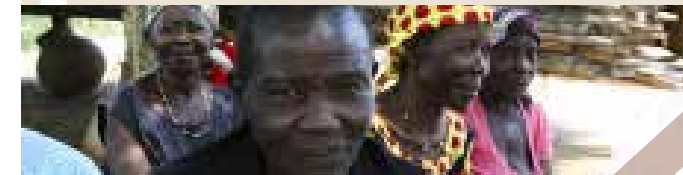
21-27 August
