You can pray individually, with a group of people from your church or as a whole church. We will support you and provide you with all the materials and helpful updates, all we ask is that you commit our work to God in prayer.

Main Responsibilities

- If possible, to meet at least once a month and pray for TLMEW.
- To encourage prayer for the work of TLMEW through your local networks including your church, your local community and with friends and family.
- We also ask that you help aid the promotion of ASK (the TLMEW prayer diary) and the regular prayer diary update to encourage others to join in praying for us too.

The whole of TLM family worldwide use the ASK prayer diary, so when you sit down to pray together you are joining staff, volunteers and patients across the TLM world.
